

**Please Note: it is an offence to park in the Taxi zone or the no parking/drop off zone at the front of the school in Renwick Street.**

A "No Parking" sign means you cannot park in this area during the restricted times at all, but you can drop off or pick up passengers or goods without leaving your vehicle (i.e. you must be within three metres of your vehicle). You must attend to your business promptly (within two minutes of stopping your vehicle). It is the law that you cannot be stationary in this area for longer than 2 minutes.

Please be respectful of our neighbours when parking and avoid parking in their driveways.

Please use our drop off zone for dropping off and picking up only.
