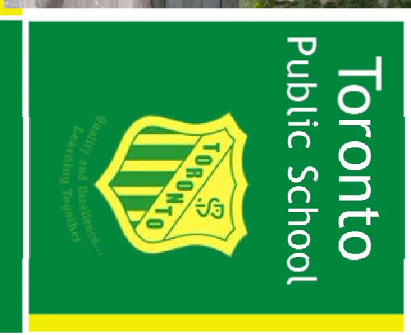

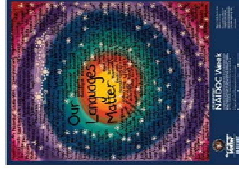

NAIDOC WEEK

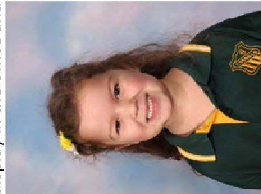
Why do we celebrate NAIDOC Week? It's a celebration of Aboriginal culture! It's an opportunity to celebrate and recognise the rich cultural history that makes Australia unique. One of the jobs of The National Aborigines and Islanders Day Observance Committee (NAIDOC) is to help us celebrate our Aboriginal culture! Not just for a day, but a whole week. Each year, a theme is chosen to reflect the important issues and events for NAIDOC Week. This year the theme aims to emphasise and celebrate the unique and essential role that Indigenous languages play in cultural identity, linking people to their land and water and in the transmission of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander history, spirituality and rites, through story and song.

Languages are the breath of life for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and the theme will raise awareness of the status and importance of Indigenous languages across the country. Each language is associated with an area of land and has a deep spiritual significance and it is through their own languages, that Indigenous nations maintain their connection with their ancestors, land and law.

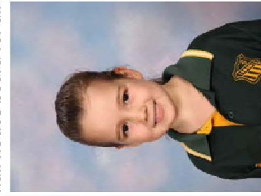


WRITING COMPETITION

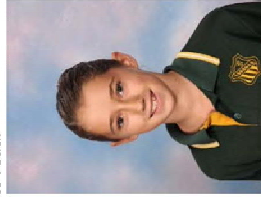

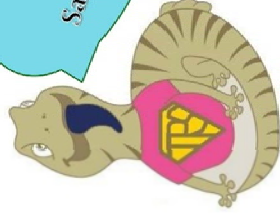

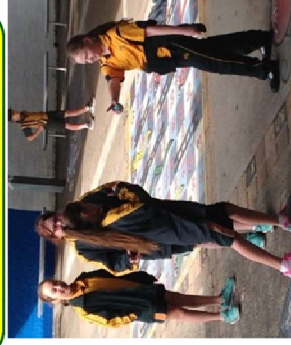
