## **NATIONALLY CONSISTENT COLLECTION OF DATA (NCCD)**

NCCD is an annual collection that counts the number of students receiving adjustment to access education on the same basis as other students. We are required to provide evidence for the number of students who receive an adjustment due to disability, the level of adjustment they receive and the broad type of disability. This information is used to assist the government to target funding to meet student needs. Students with learning difficulties or chronic health conditions that require monitoring are also included. NCCD provides the opportunity for us to review our learning and support systems and processes to continually improve educational outcomes for all students. Personal details such as student names or other identifying information are not provided to local or federal education authorities.
