Achievements and Focus

Guided Support Network Model

We have been working with the Curriculum Team and our Director on a 'Guided Support' model designed to deliver school improvement in Literacy and/or numeracy. We have engaged for 12 months and have been really delighted with what we have learnt and the impact on student performance and teaching practice. The focus is to use data to drive improvement, deliver evidenced based teaching. We have applied this understanding to comprehension 2-6 and Measurement and Geometric Reasoning 2-6.

Accelerated Adopter School

Year One are engaged in this program – supporting us to implement the new Mathematics and English Syllabus in 2022 prior to mandatory implementation in 2023. Program is supported by Simon Breakspear, been very valuable to date. We will be well positioned for a K-2 rollout in 2023.

Draw Talk Write Share

Kinder program in 2022 working with Noella Mackenzie. Engaged with other schools in our network and have been very pleased with the impact. Children are developing perseverance, self expression and willingness to express themselves both verbally and through illustrations and writing. Noella is observing lessons and providing feedback to teachers. School visit in Week 9.

Reconciliation Walk

Engaged with 1400 students from our partner primary schools. The day was a culmination of great work by our Aboriginal Education team working in partnership with our local Elders and community. We were delighted with the

response from students and all who were involved. We will evaluate the event within our RAP and with our community and partner schools to decide where to from here.
